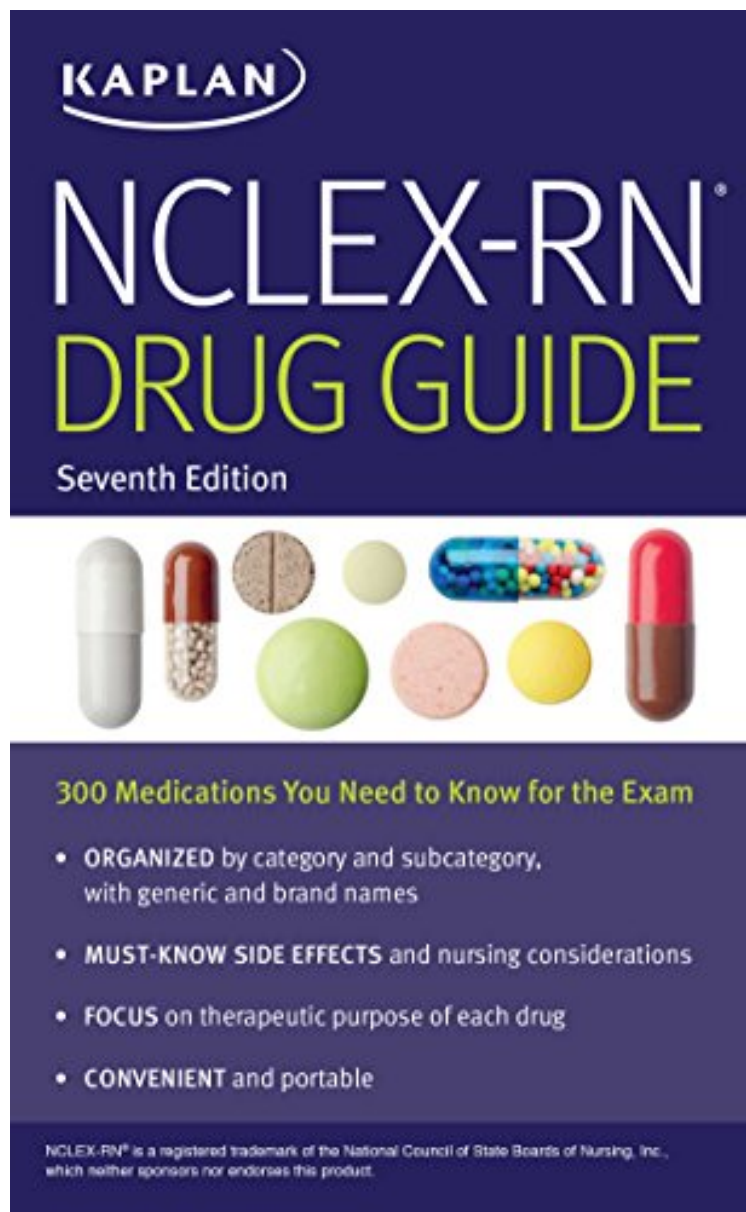

By Evan BI usually never write reviews, good or bad, but I feel I needed to warn others that are getting this to study for boards. I received this on time, and flipping through I noticed some of the drugs were repeated. On further examination I found that pages 151-214 were repeated in the book between pages 214 and 279. This would have been okay, but pages 215-278 were completely missing . This is a major quality control issue and I am very disappointed in Kaplan.

By Jen B Not very helpful. Only the most basic info is included. Only a few words to describe the drug's purpose, and one word classification, and even those are oddly placed on the page, preventing you from covering up certain information to quiz yourself. The only helpful info is the nursing considerations but those are largely elementary and repetitive. I found that some of the most commonly used meds are not included, and very few parenteral drugs are mentioned. This is not a useful study instrument and could not possibly function as a clinical drug reference for any nurse, particularly an RN. Look elsewhere.
