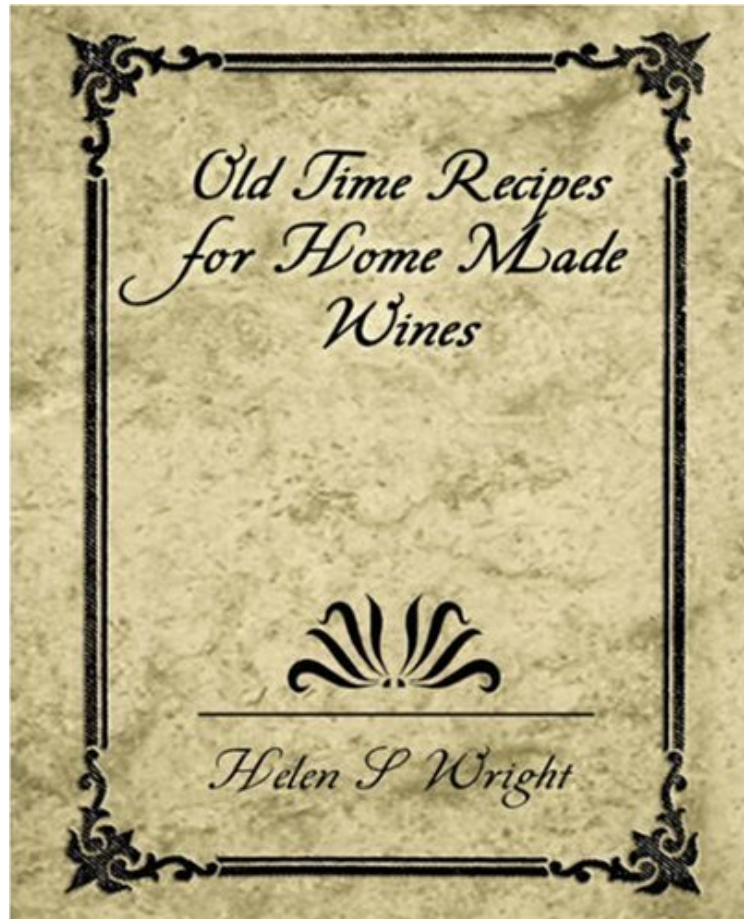

These are not really usable recipes.They are very non specific, you'll have to do research on a variety of topics before you can use these recipes. They are not written as normal recipes:"Put chips of 6 Seville oranges in a quart of brandy and let them steep a fortnight in a stone bottle close stopped...clarify the water with the white of an egg...strain through a jelly bag."If this is the type of "recipe" you're looking for, then this book is for you. If you need actual details, skip this one. Its a bit of a shame, with some research and some care, the author could have translated these recipes into great and usable directions.
