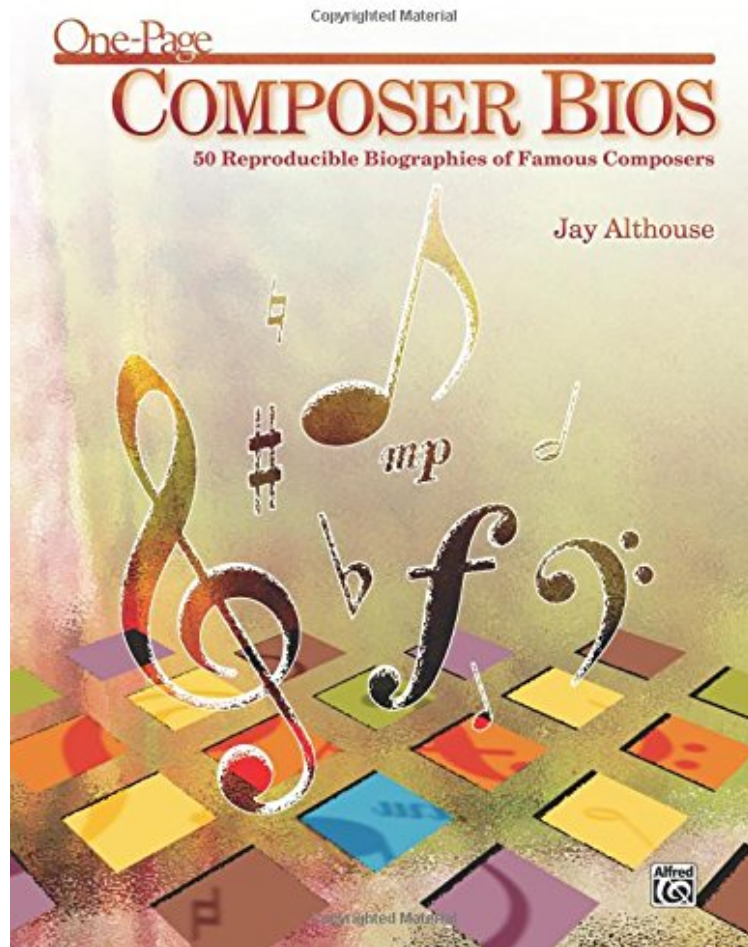

some younger children in the first through fourth grade and this is too advanced even for the parent to read to the child. I understood there was a CD which I did not realize it was a data CD with PDF files. I understood the book was reproducible but I thought you just copied the book pages. I was under the assumption the CD was short excerpts of the composers works that the children could listen to and become familiar with the music style. I have not made the decision as to whether I plan to return the book or just keep it. It is a little pricey for its quality. The only reason I may keep the book is that I cannot find a better replacement. I would like to see Alford music come out with a composer bios that accompany their classic books for beginning piano students I do appreciate the pronunciation guide for the composers. The book does have good information for older students. The data cd will make it more convenient for preparing copies for distribution. I probably would not have been disappointed if I had understood the description. I was just expecting more.
