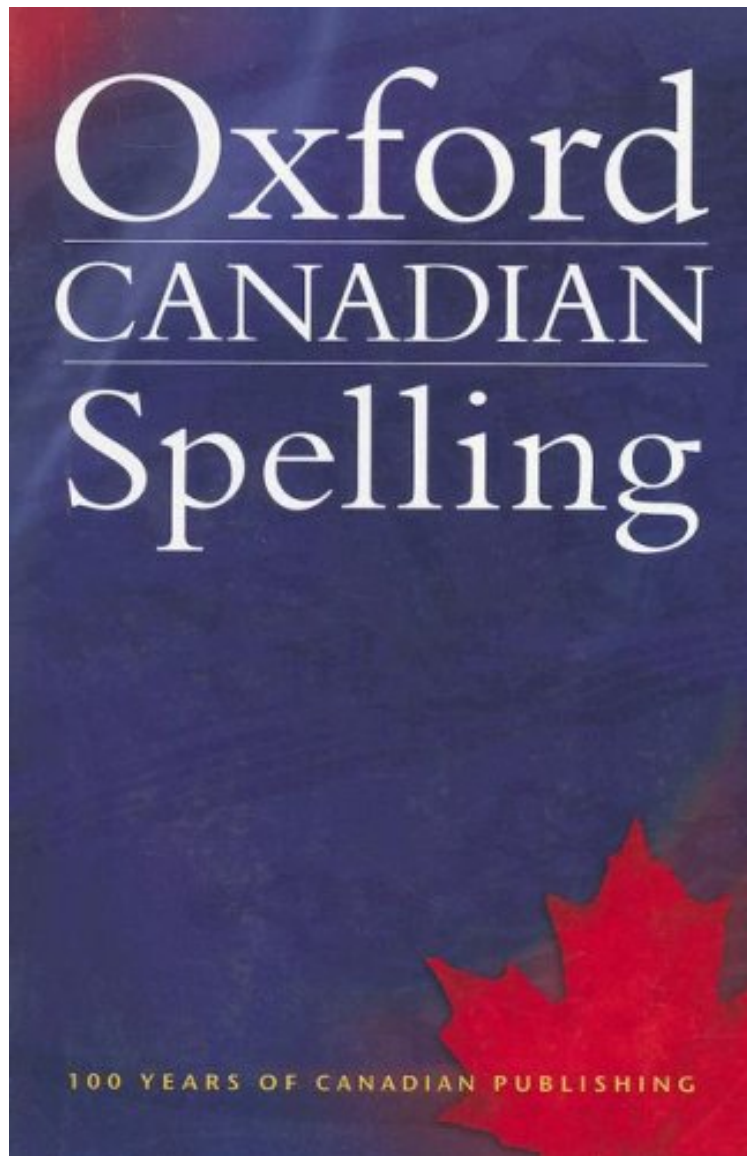

He is the coeditor of The Canadian Oxford Spelling Dictionary, and has worked on The Canadian Oxford High School Dictionary. In 2002, he was promoted to Senior Lexicographer. Born in Vancouver, BC, Eric Sinkins joined the Dictionary Department at Oxford as a lexicographer in 1996. Work on the first edition of The Canadian Oxford Dictionary was by that time well under way; as a result, Eric's contributions to work was concentrated in letters P through Z. Eric co-authored, with Robert Pontisso, The Canadian Oxford Spelling Dictionary and also worked on The Canadian Oxford High School Dictionary.
