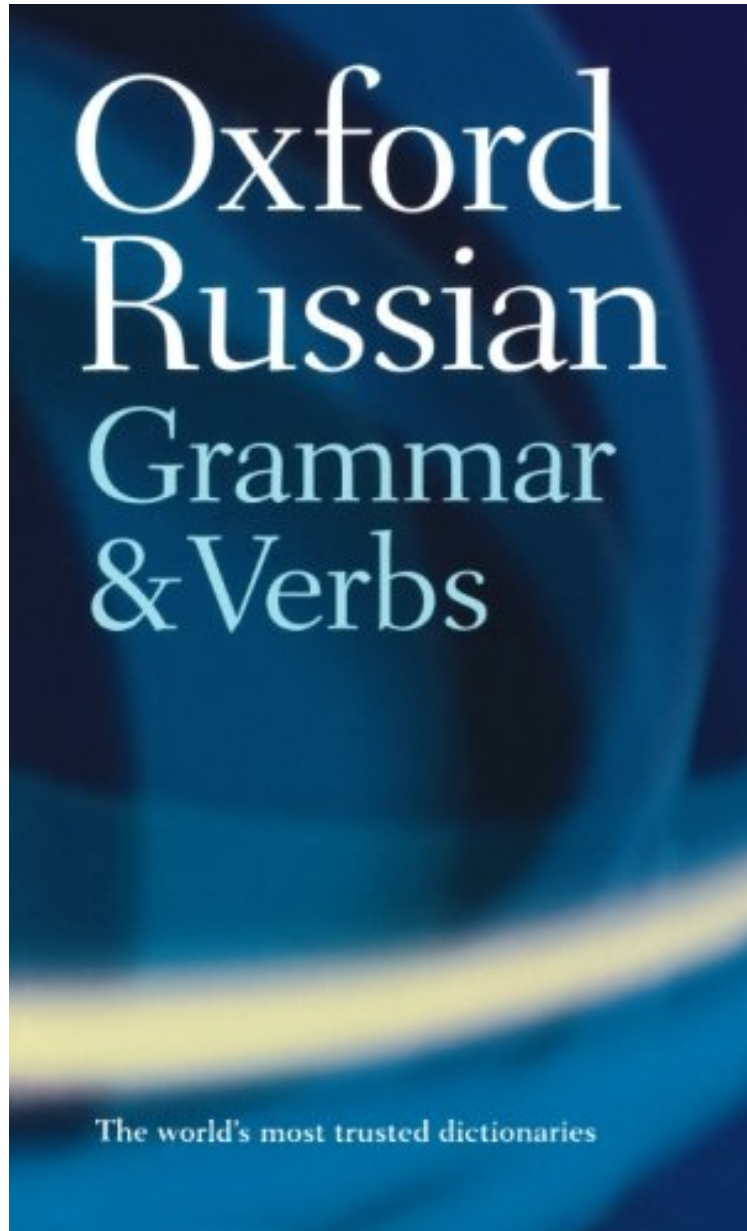

By Joel I've had this book for a while now, and for the first time I forgot to bring this hefty little book with me to my abroad program (not in Russia). When I still had this book, it was VERY detailed in specific in the full spectrum of Russian grammar. We're talking case agreement for nouns and adjectives, perfect/imperfect and unidirectional/multidirectional verb conjugations and uses, and most importantly, the high volume of irregularities found throughout the Russian language (something very beneficial for beginners if they take their time). Without this book, it's been hard for me to find the right resources to dissect Russian grammar like this little book does. I recommend this book to anyone learning Russian. If you're into Rosetta Stone or Pimsleur, keep in mind they don't break down grammar for you and it's mainly just audio.
