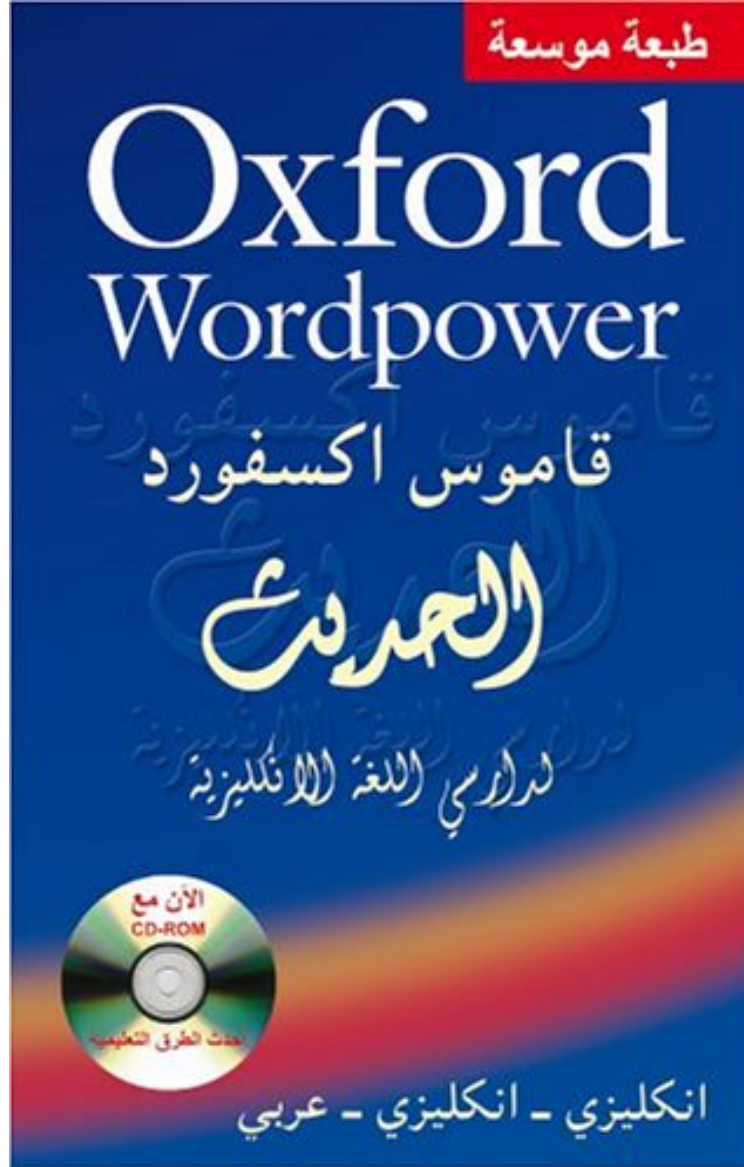

A few years ago I needed an Arabic-English dictionary in a hurry and purchased the only book at the local bookstore, "Arabic Practical Dictionary: Arabic-English English-Arabic" (ISBN: 978-0781810456). It was helpful, but

very limited. I also noticed that the students rarely looked up words in Arabic to translate into English, so this aspect of the book was not as necessary as I had supposed. Over the years, the number of my students who are native Arabic-speakers has grown and I decided to look for a better alternative. However, most of the dictionaries are either reprints of books from the 1800-1900s or are very expensive. A few weeks ago, one of my students brought this book to class, Oxford's Wordpower with Arabic translations, and asked me to purchase it as a classroom reference. I'm very happy with the book. The words are listed in English only, with English definitions followed by an Arabic translation of the word (no definition in Arabic). It also includes pictures and is clearly meant for second language learners. I have not yet had an opportunity to review the CD, but I'm hoping it will allow students to search words on their home computers. I would definitely recommend this book to ESL learners who speak Arabic as their native/first language.
