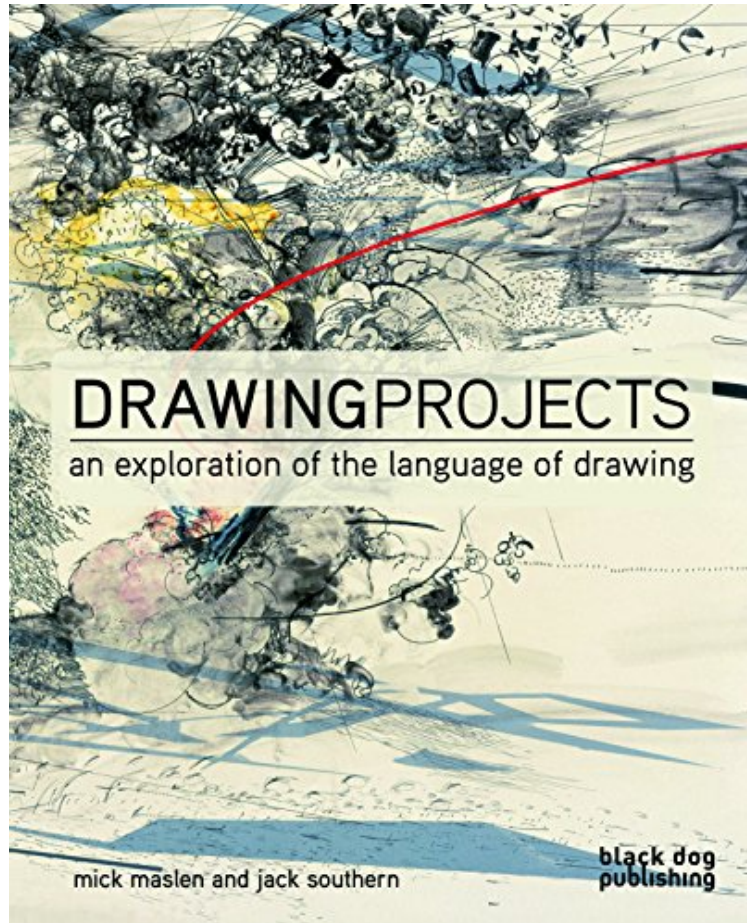

Not only is it a massive boost to one's own art making capabilities, it overrides procrastination in the sense that all the 'projects' are totally achievable with time frames of approx. 20 minutes, sometimes less. The suggestion that the need for high end expensive materials is not necessary allows for the individual to jump into it here now. It encourages us to see with fresh eyes, with exciting contemporary methods without feeling the need to copy or imitate others, giving us what artists really want: The freedom to do what we do.
