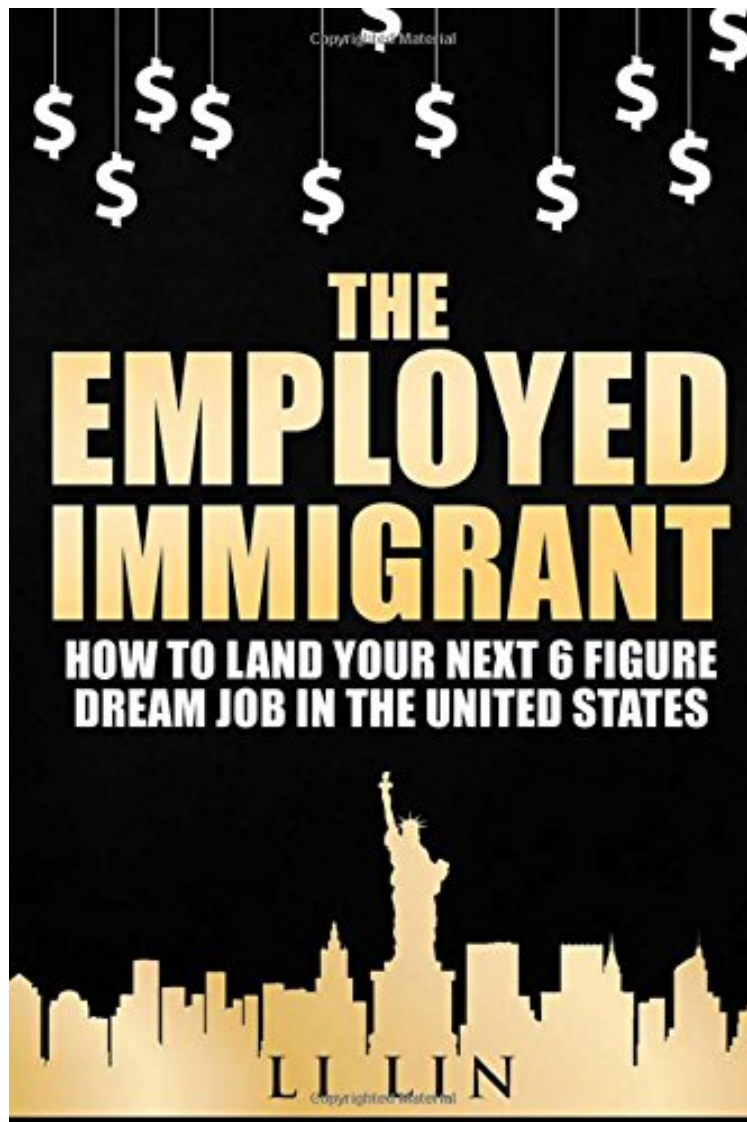

However, this is a review for this standalone book, and a standalone book should not be advertised as a standalone book if it's actually a piece of advertising for something else.If you want to write a book about this topic, make it valuable and able to stand on its own as a piece of high quality content. Not fill it with pages of generalizations and personal stories of people you have helped (which is great) but contains no actually useful or actionable advice for the reader. The only useful pieces of advice are what people intuitively know or hear all the time (get outside your comfort zone; network with people different from yourself; work on your storytelling, etc).
