I bought it as an RPG resource on someone else's suggestion. The writing is not bad, but it is very lightweight. The various entries seem to blend into one another and the tone does not inspire me. Obviously, I am not a child and it is possible that a child would find this more satisfying, but judging by the stamps and condition, I'd say the appeal was limited in any of the schools my copy did time in. I think the relative paucity of drawings is a downside, and there are no maps to help the reader place the monster in its habitat. The page numbering is eccentric too, with the number nestling in the spine rather than at the outside corners or at the page bottom. It makes looking up stuff very tedious indeed. The binding is incredibly durable given the inexpensive paper used. It should last forever in normal use. Of the four "Encyclopedias" I own by Cohen, this is the most forgettable.
