From Library JournalFor job hunters, career changers, and vocational counselors the compilers have created a useful, new occupational resource in one volume by improving The Guide for Occupational Exploration (U.S. GPO, 1979). First, they eliminate the bulk--10,000 highly specialized job titles representing five percent of the workforce--and then add job descriptions based on updated Dictionary of Occupational Titles (U.S. GPO, 1984) narratives and other information. Provided among other data are descriptions of skills, abilities, academic and physical requirements, work environment, salary, and outlook. However, the source retains the positive elements of the earlier reference, the job

titles and clusters, with the original arrangement of 12 major groupings based on interest factors and further subdivisions into work groups and subgroups.
