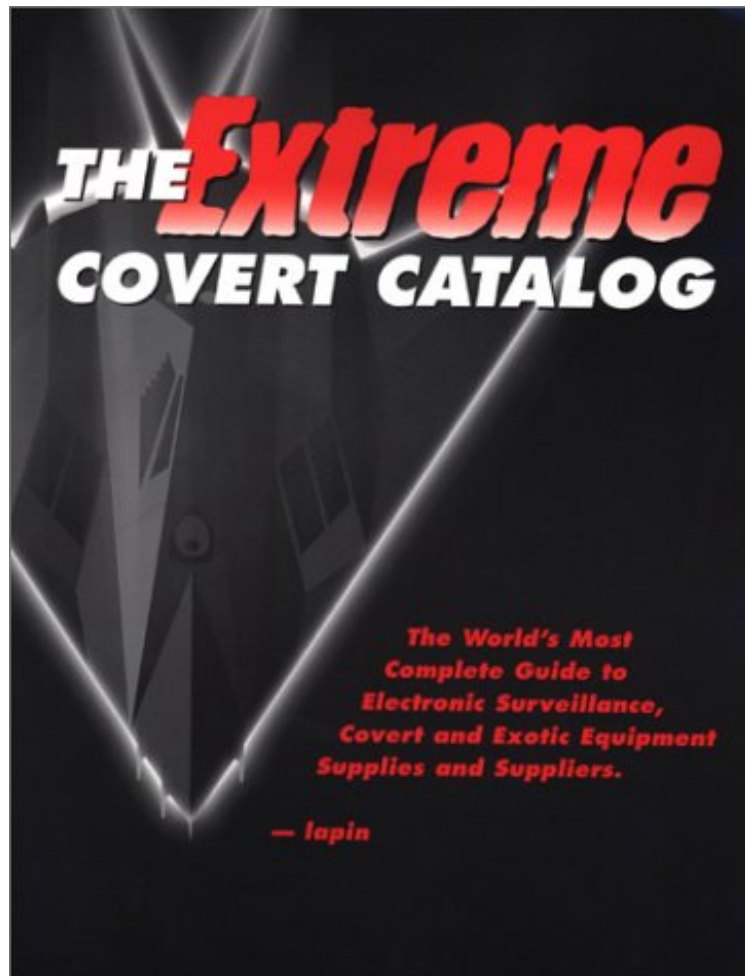

for good measure. The layout is junior-high level, the pictures are like a photograph that is on its seventh generation through the copy machine.
