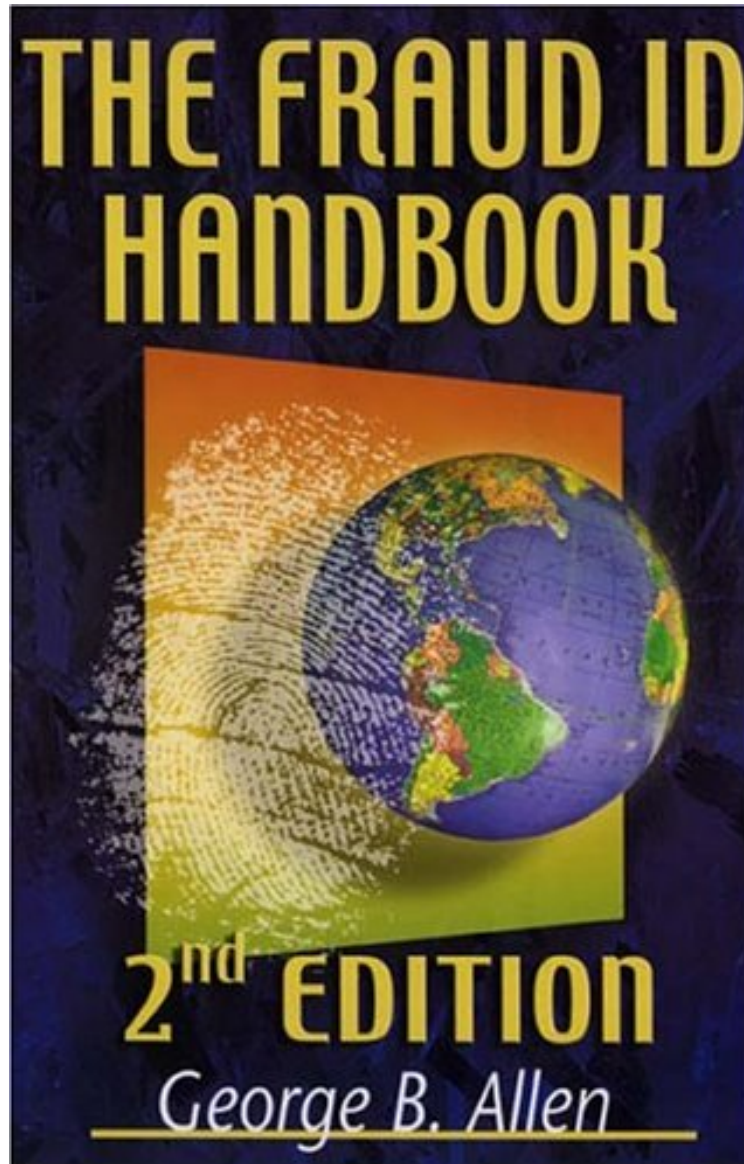

Beyond covering the common frauds--confidence games, consumer fraud, contract fraud, etc.--the Handbook includes fraud scenarios found in few other texts: fraud and terrorism, mining fraud, fraud in gems and meteorite sales, and among hundreds of others, art fraud. The first chapter provides background--with definitions and a unique discussion of the history of fraud. The final chapter summarizes the global impact of fraud and outlines preventive measures for individuals and businesses.

About the Author The author was educated as a geologist, but, mid-career, turned investigator. Mr. Allen has worked as a federal special agent, as a private insurance investigator, as an EEOC civil rights investigator, and, most recently, as a federal compliance officer.
