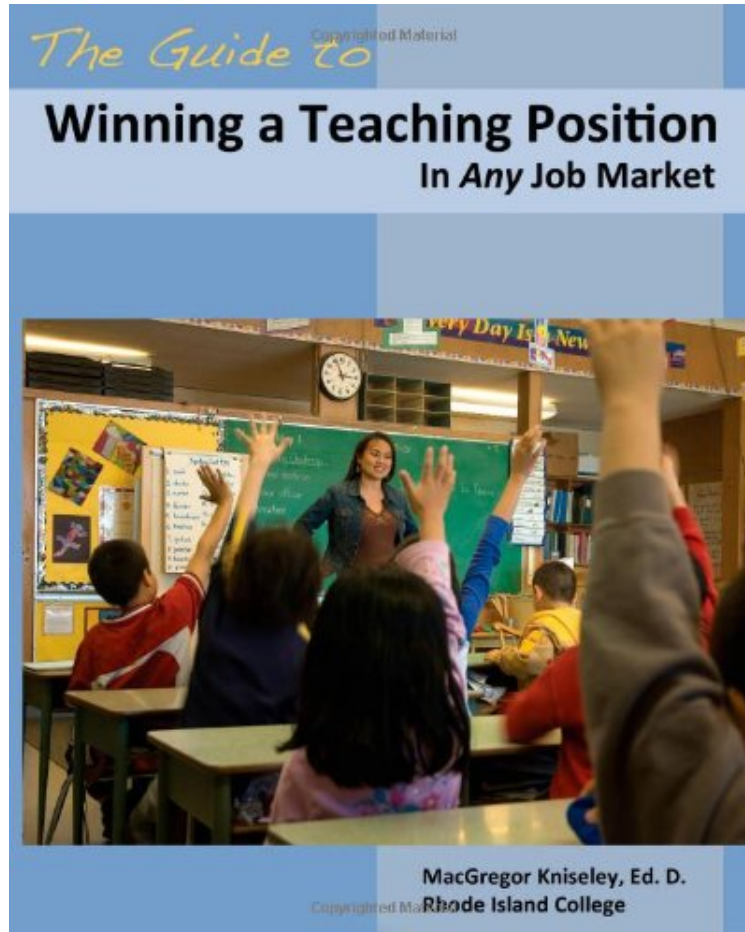


The Guide to Winning a Teaching Position in Any Job Market
