By #1The bookseller conservatively rated the condition of the set, and I was not disappointed. I'd recommend the one-volume edition from the 1960's over the four-volume one from 1948. While the former is fairly massive, each of the four volumes of the latter is rather thin. William Rose Benet was, I believe, the brother of Stephen Vincent Benet, the once-famous author of poetic epics such as "John Brown's Body" and "Western Star." I wonder how likely it is that a new work such as William Benet's will ever again appear in print, in view of the existence of Wikipedia, etc. While a work from the 1960's would be expected to lack many desired entries, the "Reader's Encyclopedia"--appreciated for what it does contain rather than for what it does not--is a useful work. It does for literature, perhaps, what the "Columbia Encyclopedia" does for "general knowledge."
