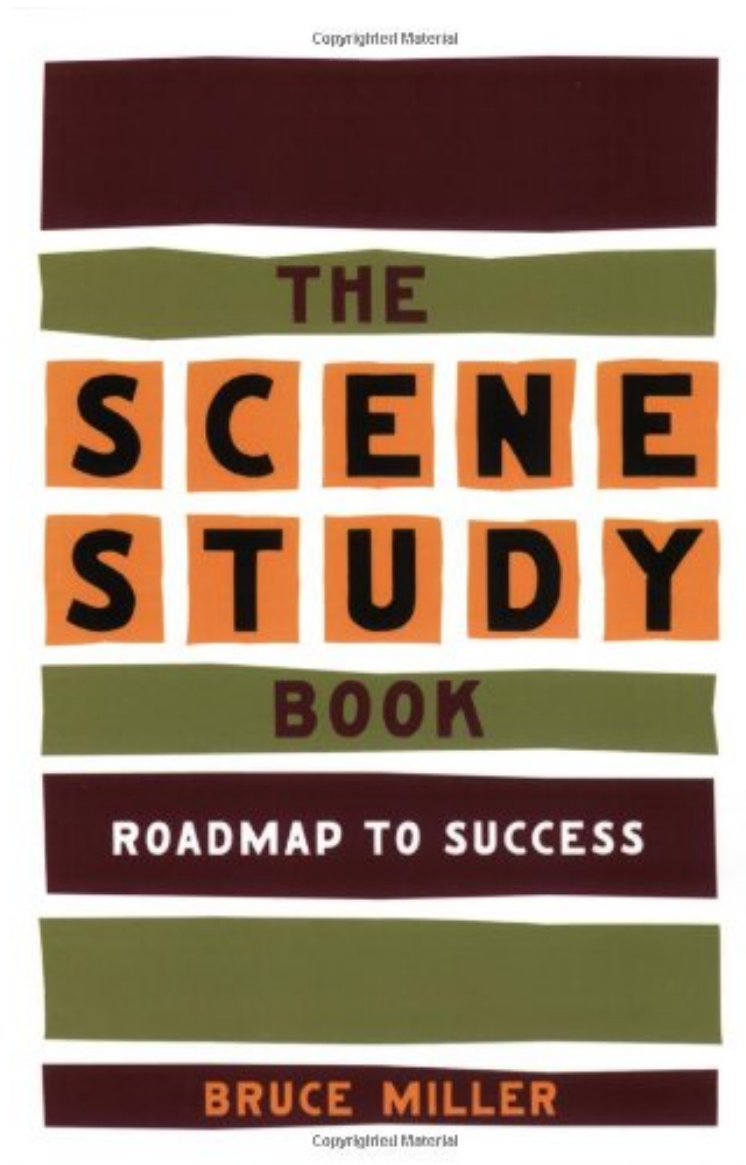

It addresses what to look for in a class, in a teacher, and in a partner.
