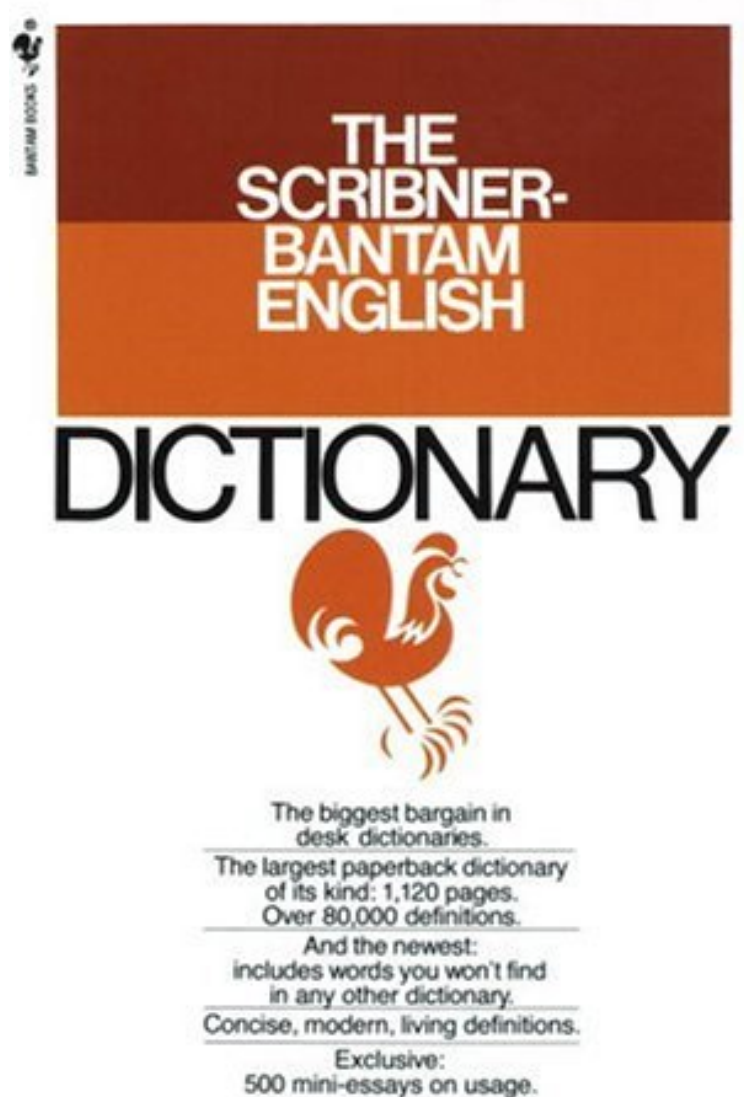

I got rid of my copy. After using multiple dictionaries, I prefer Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary (I happen to have the 10th edition). It is far superior than most dictionaries, has etymology and a large selection of words. It also doesn't tend to use a version of the same word in its definition, which many do. In other dictionaries, I've also ran into word circles, where Word #1 will use another word to define itself. You look up Word #2 and it will use Word #1 to define itself.
