It has all kinds of recipes, including basic recipes like Buttermilk Pancakes and Chocolate Waffles, to elegant Scallops a la Shaller and Sherried Oyster and Brie Soup. In the first 4 chapters, you have award winning recipe (from contests all over the country) on one side, and on the facing page full-page, beautifully photographed pictures of the finished dish. I, personally, loved the cooking classes for Italian and Chinese dishes. As a young person, this is where I learned how to make Frittata's, Crostini, Minestrone, Fettucine Alfredo, Fettuccine Carbonara, Spaghetti with Seafood Sauce, Gnocchi Verdi, Risotto Milanese, Fish Milanese, Osso Bucco, Chicken Marsala, Satay Beef, Beef with Cashews, Mongolian Lamb, Mu Shu Pork, Lemon Chicken, Tea Smoked Chicken, Ginger Chili Fish, Crispy Fish with Lemon Sauce, etc. In the Hurry-Up Hamburger section is one of my favorites, a recipe for Beef Broccoli that is entirely made in the microwave (see pic). Because it uses ground beef instead of roast or steaks, the beef is always tender, inexpensive, and full of flavor from the seasonings mixed in. Other favorites include: Chocolate Pistachio Fingers, Cowboy Cookies, Chicken with Lime Butter, Orange Cappuccino Cheesecake, Norma Gene's Peanut Butter Creme Pie, Country Breakfast Sausage, Greek Three Pepper Salad, Muffin Surprise, Thai Beef Salad with Cucumber Dressing, and Pepper Steak Sandwiches. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
