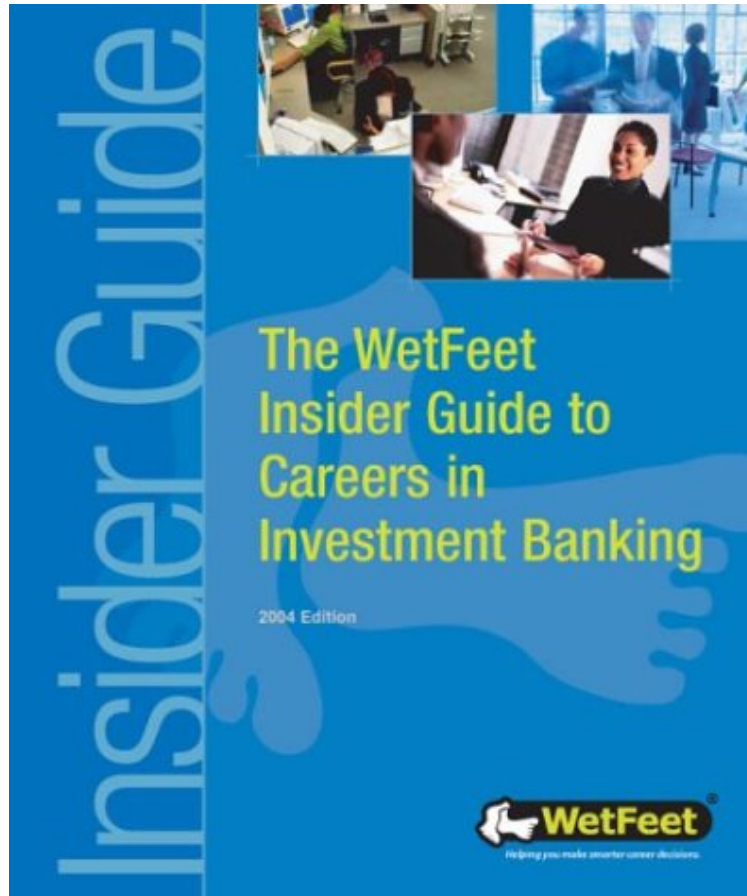

There are endless career guides to "hot" fields such as I-Banking and Management Consulting but this book sums everything up in a nice package. One thing should be noted however ; there is very little information on the technical aspects of I-Banking ( Accountancy, Finance, Economics et al ) but then again it is not the focus of the book.
