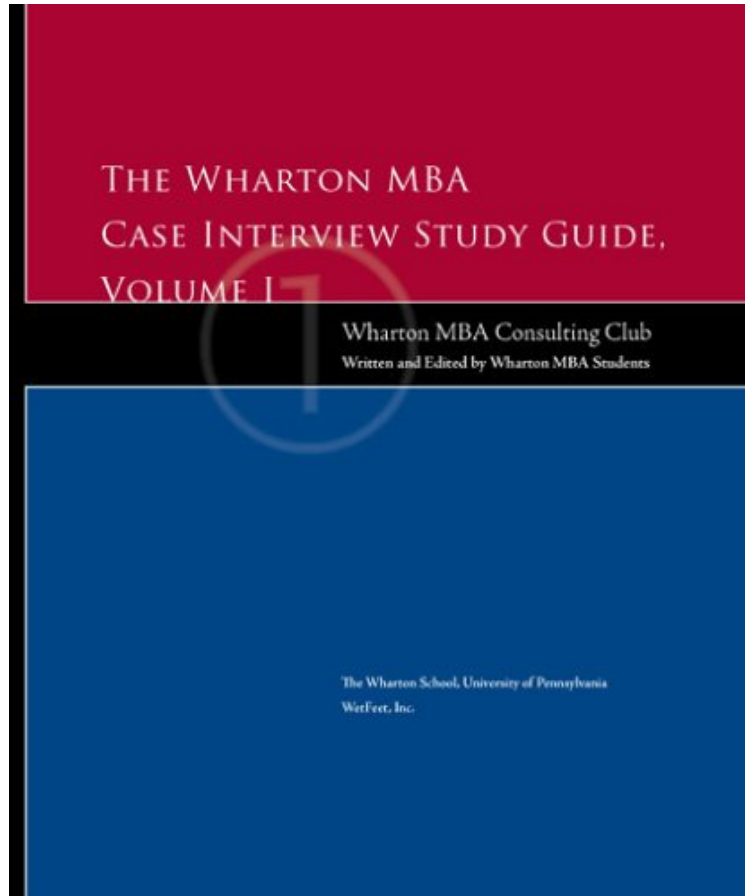

Although I do not agree entirely with all the solutions, I thought the book generally provided realistic examples, with well structured and logical solutions.One further point, although you can work through the book yourself, I would recommend that you team up with a "buddy" and alternate the role of interviewer /ee. This will stop you from jumping to the answers too soon and enable some feedback about presentation style.
