It explains well the history of many common idioms that Americans use freely in everyday language without consideration of how confounding any non-native speakers who may hear us. In addition, the book explains the meaning of the phrase as it is generally used. So if you find yourself trying to explain why you're going to just "play it by ear" rather than plan everything out, this is just the book for you!

The book is designed to help persons from other cultures who know some English but are confused by our use of English words in slang, idiomatic, and other unusual uses of such words, whether used singly or in combinations. The book focuses simply on the meaning to Americans of each expression. There are over 7,000 expressions in this small-sized 479 page book. The listings of expressions are arranged alphabetically according to a key word (s) in each expression. This key word appears in bold type. Where expressions have more than one key word, they appear at the alphabetical location of each of the key words. This minimizes the needless page flapping or cross-referencing.

The first edition of this book was published in 1989; the second edition, which was published in 1990 went through five printings. Thousands of hours were spent selecting simple and understandable meaning statements for the expressions included in this book.
