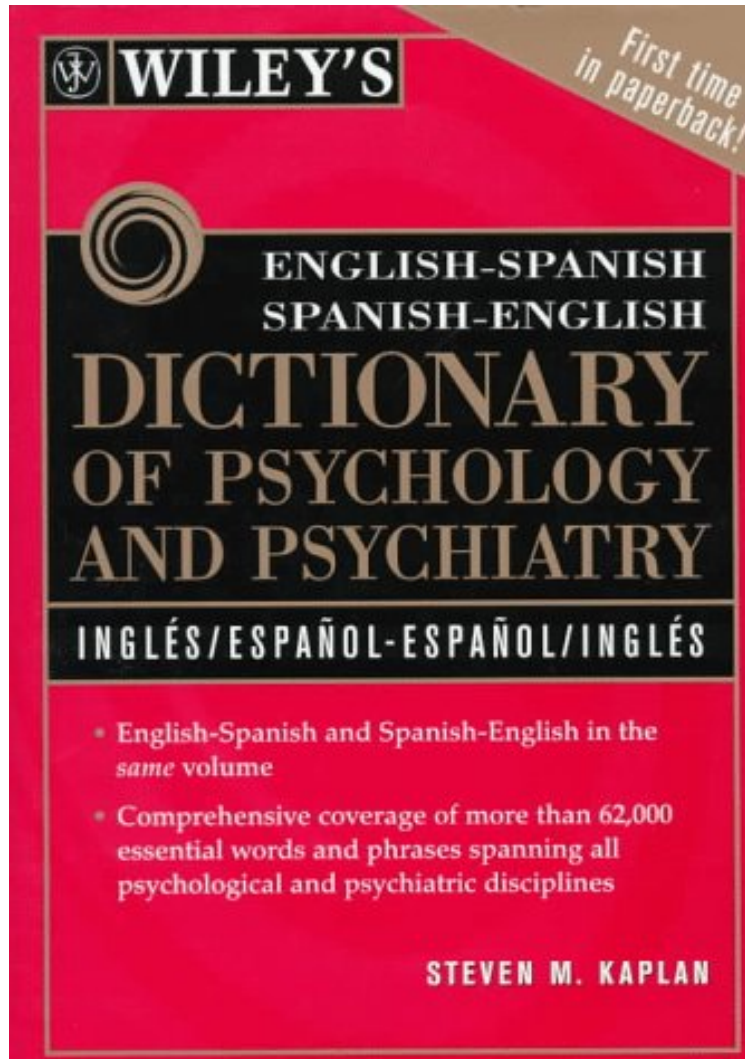

sound alike), there is no insight, no analysis, no explanations, no examples. Many of the translations that are not simple cognates are expressed in badly constructed Spanish phrases using the wrong prepositions and/or articles. This book contains LOTS OF ERRONEOUS translations!!!! It takes much more to be able to be a translator or the author of a reputable dictionary than going to a bilingual high school. Usually, most of us already speak the two languages fluently before we enroll in a translation or linguistics program and get a degree.
